During this quarter, the 15 IPF Committees have significantly contributed in the development of the institute after the induction of the 1st yr students and new faculty members in its fold. Mentioned below are some of the significant ways in which the functioning of the IPF committees had contributed in overall development of the organization and in successfully providing the students a forum to participate in all matters of relevance.

**Social Responsibility Committee:** Computer Literacy Program, which was being organized by the Department of CSE/IT/MCA till July is now taken up by this committee as an important social responsibility initiative. As such, the Computer Literacy Program held from 13th-20th December, 2010 witnessed active participation of the committee members along with the Department of CSE in making it more successful. The committee also organized for a visit of school children from the tribal belt of Rayagada dist. to its campus on 18th December, 2010, followed by a lunch hosted for the invitees. The last meeting of the committee was held on 09th December, 2010 with 9 student members participating in its proceeding.
